

TEACHER PREVIEW VISITS TO OVERSEAS ADVENTURE DESTINATIONS

PGL Teacher Previews provide you with the ideal opportunity to experience a PGL adventure before you travel with your group. You can view the accommodation and facilities, meet the staff and even have a go on some of the activities yourself!



OPTION 1: INDIVIDUAL TEACHER PREVIEW VISIT

How does it work?

You and a colleague/partner travel independently and stay at any one of our PGL centres for 3 nights during the season. (Please note: We are unable to offer Preview Visits outside our operating season.) The Centre Manager will contact you before you travel and arrange a programme designed to meet your objectives. For air travel, we will assist with information about the nearest airports and which airlines fly there. You will arrange your own flights and car hire (if required). We do not provide a booking service for preview visits transport.

What are the benefits of choosing this option?

Spend time at your chosen centre at a time that is convenient to you. You will have the opportunity to cover all your objectives and get a real taste of the PGL experience.

When does it take place?

By arrangement with our reservations staff, for any dates during the operating season only (subject to availability).

How much does it cost?

For Party Leaders with a confirmed booking PGL will provide 3 free nights full board accommodation for two people sharing a twin room and will contribute up to a total of £200 towards your travel costs. For those wishing to visit before confirming their booking, there will be a charge of £20 per person per night which will be refunded together with up to £200 towards travel costs upon confirmation of a group booking of 35 or more paying passengers for 2011 or 2012.

What's included?

- A total of £200 towards your travel expenses
- 3 nights full board accommodation on centre for 2 people
- Activities programme as agreed by the Centre Manager

OPTION 2: SHADOW A SCHOOL GROUP

How does it work?

You travel out with a school group on a coach and effectively 'shadow' them for the duration of their stay. You will need to travel to the school or another agreed pick-up point by arrangement (usually the ferry port).

What are the benefits of choosing this option?

- You see the whole cycle of an Overseas Adventure trip from your pick-up point to your return to the UK
- You see every aspect of a trip 'in action' for complete peace of mind
- You can talk to teachers and PGL staff for practical tips and recommendations

When does it take place?

At your convenience, by arrangement with our reservations staff. This kind of visit can be at any time during the season (May to end of August) as long as we have availability on the coach and at our centre.

How much does it cost?

£349 per eligible participant. A single cost of £349 is refundable on confirming a booking for an Overseas Adventure trip (minimum 35 passengers) in 2011 or 2012.

What's included?

- Return travel by air-conditioned, executive coach
- 6 nights full board accommodation on centre
- Full activities programme
- Opportunity to bring a colleague/partner at the £349 subsidised price
